SEC Chair White Announces Plan to Leave in January

WHAT HAPPENED?	On November 14, 2016, SEC Chair Mary Jo White announced that she plans to leave the Commission at the end of the Obama Administration. Chair White became the 31 st Chair of the SEC in April 2013 and advanced more than 50 noteworthy rulemaking initiatives during her service. Chair White's impact on the Commission was focused on strengthening investor protections and implementing a new approach to enforcement. By the end of her term, she will be one of the SEC's longest serving Chairs.
NEXT STEPS	President-elect Trump will be responsible for picking the next SEC chair. The nominee will then need to be approved by Congress.
