House Passes Bill Limiting SEC's Ability to Create Regulations

WHAT HAPPENED?

On January 12, 2017, the U.S. House of Representatives passed the SEC Regulatory Accountability Act, H.R. 78. This bill will require the SEC to examine its regulations through a more stringent review process before they are adopted. The review process will include identifying the problem, utilizing a cost-benefit analysis that justifies the rule, and evaluating any alternatives to the regulation. In addition, rules that have already been adopted by the SEC will be assessed every five years.
